

## **Public Review of Proposed Changes 2009 OESC**

The Ontario Electrical Safety Code (OESC), an Ontario regulation, requires government review and approval through the Ministry of Small Business Consumer Services. The Electrical Safety Authority (ESA) is currently working to submit a new edition of the OESC. The proposed 2009, 24<sup>th</sup> edition will include Ontario's amendments to the Canadian Electrical Code as well as the 2009 Canadian Electrical Code. The Regulatory Group within ESA has been working with the Ontario Provincial Code Committee and industry stakeholders to evaluate and define Code required changes and their associated impact on the industry. Numerous changes have been recommended for the proposed 2009 OESC. Proposed changes to Ontario's amendments to the Canadian Electrical Code have been posted on our website at:
